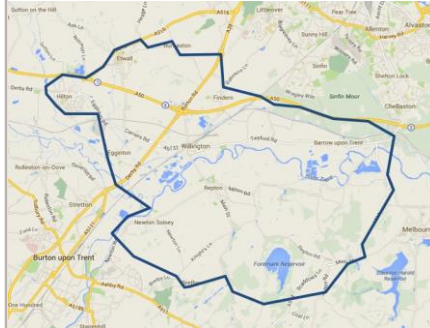

Routine Appointments

Routine appointments can be booked up to 2 weeks in advance, in person or over the telephone. You will be offered a choice of appointments but please be aware that due to the increasing workload being placed on primary care we may not be able to completely accommodate specific requests for particular times and dates. Standard appointments are 10 to 15 minutes long.

Emergency Appointments

If you have a medical problem that requires same day attention, urgent appointments are available from 8:00 every day. These are not allocated on a first come, first served basis but based on clinical need.

Please be aware that emergency appointments are there to deal with the urgent problem only. All other non-urgent problems will need to be addressed in a routine appointment.

Home visits

Home visits are reserved for housebound patients only. Please ring reception before 11am to request a home visit. Doctors may telephone in advance of visiting to assess eligibility.
